Anonymous, '*Haldeman*', H. M. Haldeman was a founding member of the Bugs of Chicago and a member of the Bohemian Club of San Francisco before founding the Uplifters in Los Angeles in the 1910's.

*Julian Petroleum Company preferred stock certificate*, 1926, The Julian Pete stock scandal involved numerous Uplifters. H. M. Haldeman was indicted for conspiracy.

Paul Popenoe and E.S. Gosney, *28 Years of Sterilization in California*, The Human Betterment Foundation, founders included Uplifter Harry Chandler, president of The Los Angeles Times, and Robert Andrews Millikan, founder of Caltech.

*The Uplifters* logos, the original featuring L.A.A.C. for Los Angeles Athletic Club and the later version following the move to Rustic Canyon. Later Uplifters included Louis B. Mayer, Will Rogers, Walt Disney, Aldous Huxley, and many others.

*Leni Riefenstahl with Siegfried and Roy and Mantecore, Las Vegas*, 1990's, Mantecore later mauled Roy, paralyzing him. Roy maintained that he suffered a stroke and Mantecore came to his rescue, gently picking him up by the neck and severing his artery, saving him from brain death.

*Wernher von Braun, director of NASA, and host of Disney's Man in Space*, 1955 Director of the Nazi V-2 program at Peenemünde, von Braun was brought to the U.S. under Operation Overcast. He was later revealed to have been an officer in the SS knowingly employing slave labor.
